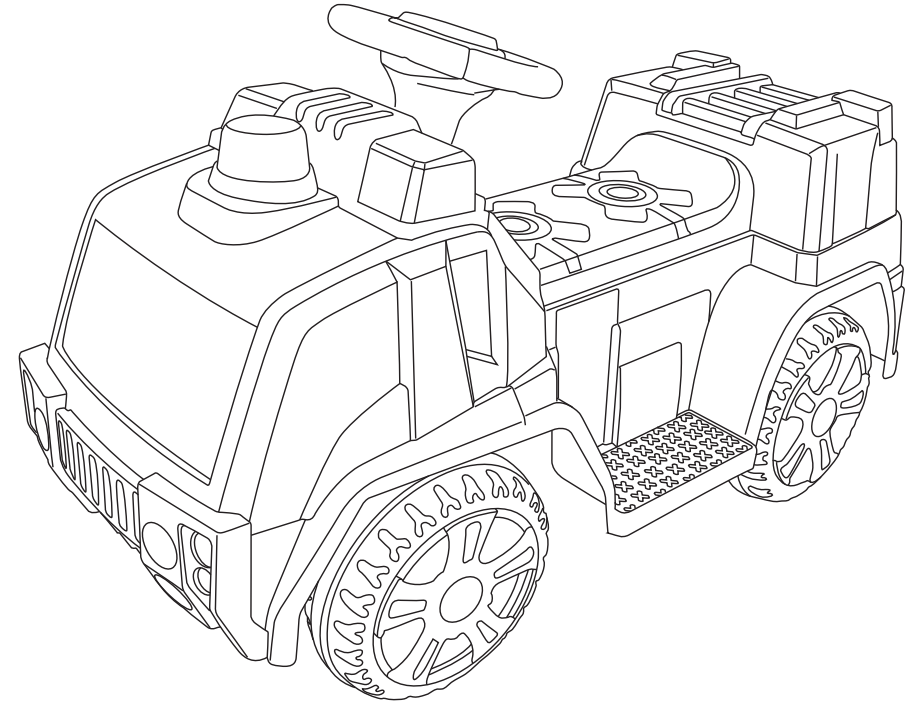

Please read carefully before using our product manual, which tells you the detailed installation and correct use, Then can avoid damage and injury caused by improper operation . WARNING:

Read entire instructions carefully before assembling this product.
To avoid injury to small parts children under 3 years old prohibited.

WARNING: ASSEMBLY

- Keep these instructions for future reference.
- Prior to assembly, this package contains small parts: hardware which is a choking hazard and may contain sharp edges and sharp points. Keep product away from children until assembled.
- Ensure working area is free of danger, always dispose packaging material in such a way that it may not cause any harm.
Plastic bags can be dangerous. To avoid suffocation keep plastic bags away from babies and children.
- To prevent serious injury, children must not use the equipment until completely assembled.
- Spare parts exchange should be operated by an adult, because the battery is very heavy and the internal acidic electrolyte, if any leakage should avoid touch the liquid, and need a professional disposition. If accidental with the electrolyte, it is timely at least 15 minutes rinse with cold water and seek medical treatment.

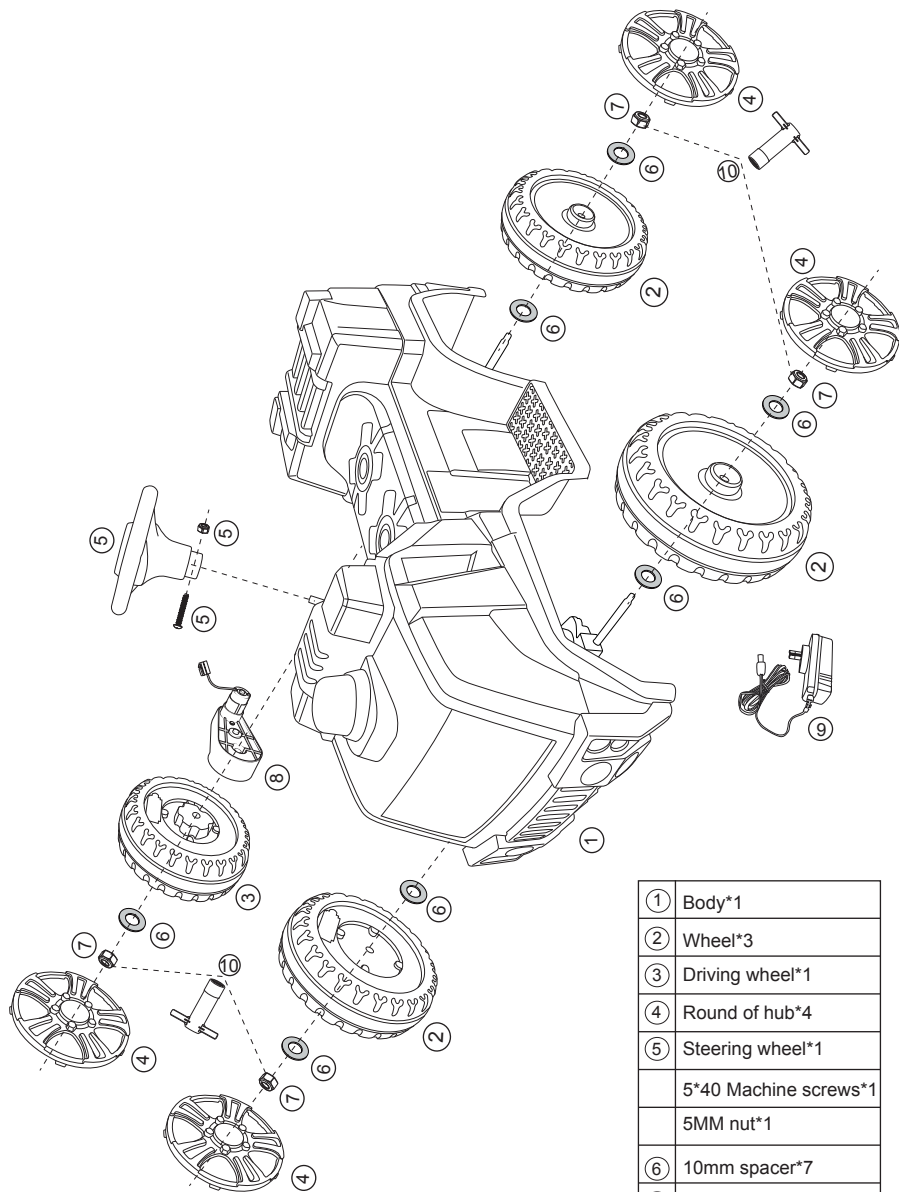

TO AVOID SERIOUS INJURY: Continuous adult supervision is required while this vehicle is in operation.













- To reduce the risk of injury, adult supervision is required. DO NOT leave the child play vehicle alone to avoid accidents.
- NEVER use in or near roadways, near motor vehicles, on or near steep inclines or steps, swimming pools or other bodies of water and dangerous place, always wear shoes, and NEVER allow more than 1 rider.
- NEVER allow children to ride at night.
- Instruct children on proper use of this product and to sit properly when driving. DO NOT RIDE VEHICLE STANDING UP.
- It is recommended that the rider always wears safety equipment such as fitted helmet when riding the vehicle.
- Ride-on toys should be used with caution since skill is required to avoid falls or collisions which may cause injury to the user.
- The vehicle is intended for use on flat, level surfaces.
- DO NOT ride the vehicle indoors. It is intended for outside use ONLY. Interior floors can be damaged by riding the vehicle indoors.
- DO NOT tow objects behind the vehicle or overload the vehicle as doing so will cause damage.

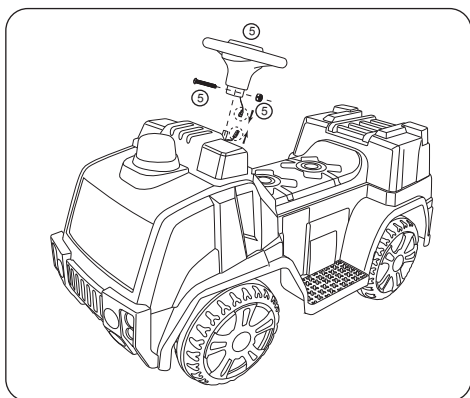

(F) ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM

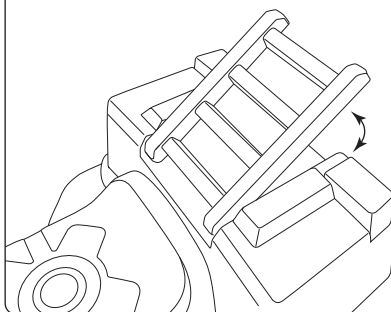




Before using it for the first time, lift up the seat then open the seat plate, unscrew the screws and connect the main wire to the battery wire (with RED to RED) any wrong connection may cause short circuit or other faults.



Fire ladder can be up and down.



Attention: Before assembling the steering wheel, connect the plug on the steering wheel with the plug on the car body.

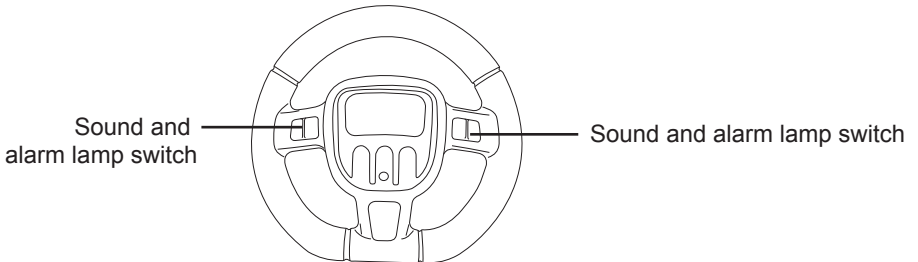
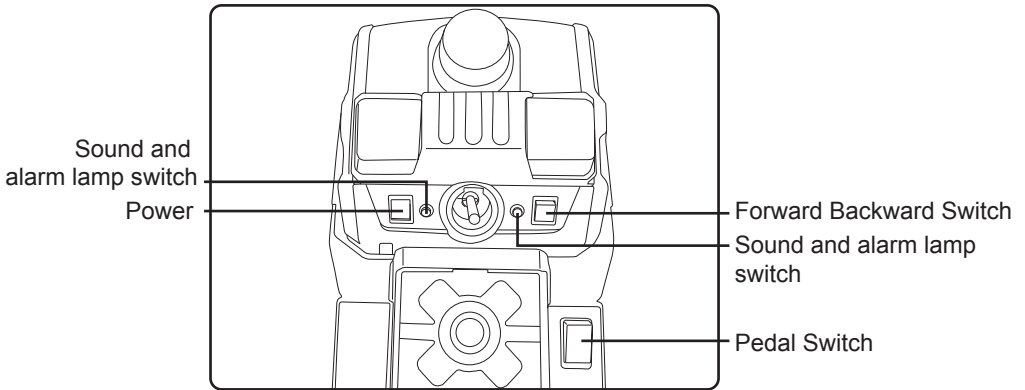
(G) USE INFORMATION

NOTE:

- (1) The car has the music function.
- (2) Charge the battery if the vehicle runs slower than normal.
Recharge the battery for 8-12hours after each use, DO NOT exceed 15hours.
- (3) It is normal that the power charger and the battery become warmer while on charging
- (4) TURN OFF the power switch always when you're not using vehicle

FUNCTION:

- (1) START: Press POWER switch(see below diagram) and step on the PEDAL switch (see below diagram)
- (2) FORWARD/BACKWARD function: Press FORWARD switch and step on the PEDAL switch, the vehicle will go forward; Press BACKWARD switch and step on the PEDAL switch, the vehicle will go back
- (3) SOUND/LAMP function: Press switch(as below diagram)



(H) FUSE

The vehicle use self-tapping fuse.

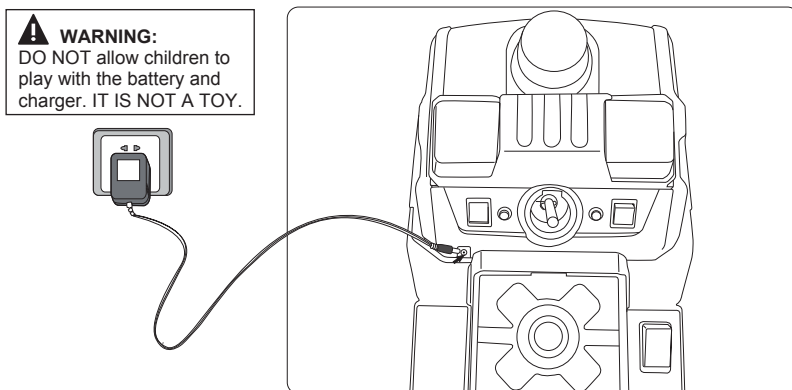
When overloading or improper use, the fuse will be automatically cut off in 10-20 seconds and then will automatically connect the power.

To avoid the cutting off, please pay attention:

- (1) The maximum weight limited of the motorcycle is 20KG.
- (2) Not stall the car running or heavy trailer behind.
- (3) Do not liquid immersion, it may cause the short circuit.
- (4) Do not revise the vehicle's circuit or the structure.
- (5) Do not use the different specification fuse.

(I) CHARGING AND BATTERY SAFETY

As shown in below diagram, put the charger into the vehicle's charging hole, and the power plug into the matched stable AC power



NOTE:

- (1) To assure the safety, battery charging and replaced only done by an adult.
- (2) Insert battery with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- (3) First using, fully charge at least 10 hours, normal recharging 8~10 hours after every using, but NEVER charge over 15 hours.
- (4) CHECK the charger, battery and plug before every charging, DO NOT use if it is broken.
DO NOT upside down the battery when charging.
- (5) DO NOT open or decompose the battery and charger, ONLY USE the type battery and charger recommended for the unit.
- (6) DO NOT short-circuit battery.
- (7) DO NOT recharge non-rechargeable battery.
- (8) DO NOT mix old and new or different type of batteries.
- (9) DO NOT dispose of battery in fire as it may leak or explode.
- (10) Exhausted battery is to be removed from the toy.
- (11) When vehicle is not used for an extended time, remove battery to prevent possible leakage and damage to the unit.
Charge the battery once per three months to extend the lifetime of the battery.

(J) CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- (1) Adults should check regularly such as wires, plugs, electrical, housing, steering systems, fastening is normal or not, once every two weeks suggested. If there is any problem, STOP use until the fully restored.
- (2) Clean vehicles with soft and dry cloth, can not use water or fuel cleaning that will lead to corrosion switch and caused switch failure.
DO NOT wash with soapy water or spray vehicle with a hose.
DO NOT wipe vehicle with car wax or other was-based polish.
- (3) DO NOT drive vehicle during wet or snowy weather as moisture can cause corrosion in the motor or electrical switches.
DO NOT drive vehicle on gravel or sand as doing so may cause motor to jam.
- (4) Store vehicle indoors or cover with a protective tarp during inclement weather.
DO NOT store the vehicle in the high-temperature places or near the fire, or in moist places.
- (5) When vehicle is not used on a regular basis, please pull out the battery, the switch must be "off" position to ensure circuit safety. Charge the battery once per three months to extend the lifetime of the battery.
- (6) DO NOT make modifications to this vehicle.
When maintenance, do not revise the vehicle's circuit and structure.
- (7) ONLY use the battery charger which comes with this vehicle. Not doing so may cause irreparable damage, including fire or explosion which may result in injury to the user.
- (8) In the unstable supply voltage region, we recommended to instal voltage stabilizer to protext the battery.

(K) TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

Problem	Possible Solutions
The vehicle does not move	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Charge the battery. (Charge battery after each use.) NOTE: vehicle will be cut off electricity during charging. · Check all electrical connections. · Check all switch whether "on" position. · Check foot switch or manual button is stuck down so that can not press. · The fuse may have been activated due to excessive weight or weight or rough driving conditions. Wait at least 10~20 seconds, and the vehicle will reset itself. · Check is whether there is debris stuck wheels.
The vehicle begins to run slow	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Charge the battery. (Charge battery after each use.) · Only allow one rider at a time. DO NOT exceed child weight limit: 20kg · Drive on level ground. · Battery may be old or not accepting a full charge. The battery will last from 1 to 3 years depending on care, use and environment. Replace with 6Volt 4.5 Ah battery only. · Check is whether there is debris stuck wheels.
The vehicle runs erratically	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · There may be a problem with the fuse, or you may have a damaged battery.
The charger feels warm when in use	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · This is normal.
The gears sound very loud and/or are making a grinding noise.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · The gears may be broken.
