Installation steps



- 1. Install the steering wheel:
 - (1) Connect the wire for steering and panel board;
 - (2) Fix the steering rod.(see picture 1)
- 2. Install the rear tail fins: Put the rear tail fins into the slot.(see picture 2)









- 3. Install the back wheel:
 - (1) Put the gear box into the axle and motor hole.(see picture 3)
 - (2) Fix the back wheel.
- 4. Install the seat:
 - (1) Connect the motor drive wire and the control wire under the seat.
 - (2) Insert the clip of the both side of seat into recess hole.
 - (3) Use screw to lock the seat.(see picture 4)
- 5. Install the front wheel:
 - (1) Put shim on the front wheel axle.
 - (2) Fix the front wheel. (see picture 5)


Directions for use -



 Battery charging: when the power is low, please charge in time. The charging plug hole is in down right the panel board (upper the pedal)



2. Control by hand: sit safely and turn on the power. When it is in the position of manual control, press the pedal and you can go forward or back, while using the "go forward and back" gear shift lever. (see picture 7)



3. The safety wire: the car adopts self-recovering safety wire, when the electricity is over 20A, it will cut the power, after 5-10 seconds, and it can recover by itself. (see picture 8)

Warning

Please keep and read the instructions carefully before using. If not following the instructions, there may cause the risk of hurt to the child and the car. For your child's safety, please pay attention to the following warnings:

- Installation should be done by adults; Keep child away from the moving parts.
- Not suitable for using by child less than 36 months because of small parts inside.
- Make sure of using safe belt correctly during driving; keep away from fire!
- The children can not drive alone without adults.
- Don't let the children stand on the step board (or in the car).
- After charging the storage battery by the adults, the children can use the car.
- Put the plastic bags far away from the children in case of suffocation.
- Forbid using any spare parts not produced by the manufacture.
- Battery should be put in with right polarity.
- Do not take the charger as a toy.
- Do not load more than 30kg.
- Suit age for the car is 3+ years.
- Non storage battery can not be charged; take the exhausted battery out.
- Do not allow short circuit on power terminal.
- The car is not allowed to be connected to power -supply more than suggested.

Kind reminder for charging

- Make sure the battery has been charged over 18 hours before the first use.
- Connect the charge DC plug, and then connect the charge into the power supply. Do not make any operation during charging.
- After 1 hour using, you should charge in time. It takes 8-12 hours to charge normally.
- Do not charge over 20 hours.
- It is normal to have some heat for charger and battery when it is charging (lower than 60°C).
- Charging in wet may cause short circuit.
- Make sure use the self-contained charger and battery to avoid any damage of circuitry. Charge the battery once a month at least when the car is not driven for long time.

Kind reminder

- Make sure the battery has been charged over 18 hours before first use, otherwise it will be damaged forever.
- Do not drive the car on the slipped street, road, slop or other dangerous places.
- Do not drive the car on smooth surface, such as marble and floor tile.
- Do not transfer the switch "go forward" to "go back" during the advance. Do not allow the children stand on the seat. Do not make any changes of the circuitry or other electriferous device.
- Do not put or immerse water or any other liquid on the car, to avoid damage of circuitry.
- When the car meets some obstacle, it will stop. Please drive after getting across the obstacle.
- Do not drive the car indoor, in case of cracking up the furniture or tumbling down the children.
- When the power is low, the car can just go forward, but not left or right. When it can't go farther or shake etc, please change the battery at once.
- The car can carry one child only with maximum of 30KG.
- Please turn off the power when not driving. If the car is not driven for a long time, please cut off the battery connector.

WARNINGS: Forbid the child opening or changing batteries by himself.

Maintenance

- In order to keep your baby away from accidental injury, please check and maintain the car regularly.
- Make sure all parts are complete before installation; if there is any problem, please contact us as soon.
- Please check periodically whether the screws are loose or the accessory parts are damaged.
- Make sure every part is complete before installation and use.
- Please clean the car regularly; do not damage the electrical device.
- Please install and disassemble the car according to the specification, to avoid causing unnecessary damage.
- Please check the car and the charger to make sure there is no damage of the electrical wire, plug and other parts regularly. If find any damage, stop use until repair.

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

Where a failure does not amount to a major failure, we are entitled to choose between providing you with a repair, replacement or refund.
